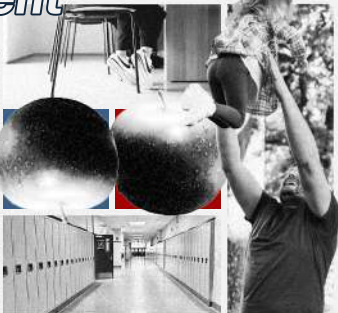

When relocating to a new city for their work, parents can find an apartment near a school with great disability resources using Zillow's school quality rating tool powered by the Department of Education's Civil Rights Data Collection through GreatSchools.org.

paying teachers what they're worth



A school district is able to make the case for increased teacher salaries using the *Department of Education's Civil Rights Data Collection* to demonstrate that teachers in their district are underpaid compared to those in neighboring districts.
